Animals must be checked in on the fairgrounds no later than noon, Thursday, September 25th. Open livestock will be judged prior to the 4H/FFA classes for each division. Animals will be released Sunday at 5:00pm. The Fair Association shall reserve the right to limit entries to facilities available and may limit the number of entries made by an exhibitor. Any limits under this rule will be done generally and without discrimination. The Superintendent shall have full charge of barns, stalls and pens including the assignment of the same.

Exhibitors are responsible to the Superintendent for the cleaning of their stalls and pens. This should be done twice daily or as frequently as necessary. The feeding and watering of livestock is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors of individual animals must furnish their own feed boxes and watering buckets. Transportation, feed, bedding (shavings) and care of the animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor. The Fair Association and/or the Superintendent, will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to any livestock exhibited.

No premium ribbon decorations previously won by an animal shall be exhibited prior to judging. All animals in livestock classes must be owned by the exhibitor. Each Class may have entries in Lots as listed below the Classes. In entering, indicate the Class and Lot Numbers.

DIVISION A - BEEF CATTLE

CLASS NO. 90 - ANY RECOGNIZED BREED

If enough animals of certain breeds are exhibited, Classes 91-92 may be added.

The following Lots apply to all Classes of Heifers:

DIVISION B - DAIRY CATTLE

CLASS NO. 93 - ANY RECOGNIZED BREED

If enough animals of certain breeds are exhibited. Classes 94-95 may be added.

The following Lots apply to all Classes of Dairy Cattle:

- 34 Cow 2 years and under (July. 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006)

DIVISION C - SWINE

CLASS NO. 96 - ANY RECOGNIZED BREED

If enough animals of certain breeds are exhibited, Classes 97-98 may be added.

DIVISION D - SHEEP

CLASS NO. 99 - ANY RECOGNIZED BREED

DIVISION E - DAIRY GOATS

All does in milk must be milked dry between the hours of 6 and 7 p.m. the evening prior to judging. (No Billy Goats will be accepted.)

CLASS NO. 102 - ANY RECOGNIZED BREED

If enough animals of certain breeds are exhibited, Class 103 may be added.
