General instructions and rules: To enter one must be a resident of Cochise County at the time of entry

No entries which have previously won any place in any category at the Cochise Country Fair within the last five years may be submitted. Judges may use their discretion in making awards and have the right to disqualify an entry, which they determine to be out of category, does not comply with the rules, or is inappropriate for the exhibit.

**Exhibits will be received Wednesday, September 24 from 10:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. and Thursday, September 25 from 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M.**

**SPECIAL AWARDS:**

Best of Show ribbon will be awarded for the outstanding print, in open class. The Popular Appeal Award will be given to the print receiving the most popular votes in Adult and Youth categories. Popular votes cast by viewers at the Photograph Exhibit area will cease at 10:00 p.m. Saturday, September 27, and the winner will be announced at opening Sunday, September 28.

**Special Rules:** Minimum print size is 8 x 10 up to a maximum print size of 16 x 20 inches. All prints must be matted and mounted on, heavy cardboard or mat board so that the photograph will stay rigid when hung. **Prints in frames will not be accepted. Exhibitor's name, mailing address, the Class and Lot Numbers, as well as the title of the photograph, must be put on the backside of the mount.**

Tape the exhibitor's tag, by the string, so that the tag can be seen.

If there is any question as to which way the photo should be displayed please indicate "TOP" and "BOTTOM" on the back of the print.
